Then, Under the General tab, the 3rd question is "Do you intend to use one of these school-specific fee waivers from the drop-down list, highlight and select "Other Valid Fee Waiver." St. Mary's College of Maryland	St. Mary's College is waiving application fees for first-generation college students. This is defined as a student whose parent(s) have not completed a bachelor's degree. This means that the student is the first in his or her family to attend a four-year college to attain a bachelor's degree. Valid until application deadline.	On the St. Mary's application, if a student doesn't fill in any info regarding their parents having a bachelor's degree, the fee will automatically be waived. University of Maryland Eastern Shore	No fee <u>November 1-30</u> for Delaware high school students.	Students choose "fee waiver" on the application. Then, they can either (1) have a counselor send their transcript and attach the fee waiver flyer through Parchment or Naviance OR (2) have a counselor email the fee waiver flyer along with the student's name to Sanda Spellman in UMES admissions (sspellman@umes.edu). Washington College	No fee for Delaware high school students. No time limit.	If students use the Washington College application, there is no fee.
