Delaware Technical Community College

May/June **Financial Aid**

The deadline for financial aid is June 1st! Students can apply after this time, but it is not guaranteed that there will be a decision before payment for courses is due. Make sure you apply today!

June/July/August **Student Handbook**

May **Housing**

Remember to pay your \$150 housing deposit. Housing assignments will be sent out mid-July

June/July **Student Orientation**

SOAR (Summer Orientation and Academic Registration) is a one-day, mandatory orientation with dates available in June and July. SOAR registration opens as soon you make your deposit with Admissions. Registration information and the dates can be found at www.wesley.edu/orientation.html.

August **Student Orientation Continued**

WOW (Windows on Wesley) is a four-day orientation on August 20th. This program is a continuation of SOAR and is also mandatory. The total fee for both programs is \$250.

May/June **Enrollment**

Once you receive your acceptance, begin registering for courses using your WilmU student portal at webcampus.wilmu.edu/.

July/August **Math Placement**

If you did not score above a 450 on the math, critical reading, and writing sections of the SAT, you must complete the Math and English Skills Assessments. For more information and to register: www.wilmu.edu/testing/englishmath.aspx.

General Reminders

May

Enrollment Deposit

Only a few months to go before you begin a new adventure in college – have you submitted your enrollment deposit? Colleges typically require this in May or June to reserve your spot for the fall semester. If you haven't already, now is the time to submit your deposit. If you have questions regarding the enrollment deposit, contact the Admissions office at the school you will be attending!

New Student Orientation

Have you signed-up for your student orientation this summer? Most schools hold an orientation for new students in June, July, or August. Some schools only have one date that all incoming freshman attend, and other schools will have several different orientation sessions that you can choose from. If the school you are attending is relatively close, make sure you register for your orientation! If you are attending a school that is farther away, make sure you contact the Admissions office for any important information that you might want that is discussed at orientation.

June

Important Forms

The start of your first semester in college is getting closer! Have you submitted all of the required paperwork to your college or university? Most schools require a health history form and a final official high school transcript before you can register for classes. Some schools might require a student conduct policy agreement. If you haven't done so already, make sure you submit your paperwork ASAP! If you are unsure about what forms are necessary at your school, contact the Admissions office for more information!

Housing Preferences

If you plan to live on-campus for your freshman year, you need to submit a form that indicates your housing preference to ensure that you have a space in the residence halls! Make sure you submit this form (either a paper copy or electronically) to your school as soon as possible! The Admissions team will be able to assist you with any questions.

July

Placement Exams

Does your school require placement exams? Most schools will ask that you take a math placement and/or writing placement exam to determine which level you will need to take to fulfill your core class requirements. If you plan to pursue a foreign language, you might have to take a language placement exam as well. Be sure to contact your school about the timing of placement exams!

August

Class Registration

Only a few more weeks until your post-secondary adventure begins! If you have not registered for classes for the upcoming semester, now is the time to do so! Contact your Admissions office or academic department to determine the courses that you need to take or with registration questions.
