

Delaware Tech SEED Scholarship

WHAT: The Student Excellence Equals Degree (SEED) scholarship provides *free* tuition for Delaware high school graduates to attend Delaware Tech or the University of Delaware's Associate in Arts Program, where a student can complete two years at Delaware Tech tuition free and then transition to the University of Delaware or other higher education institution to complete a bachelor's degree.

REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must:

- Have a 2.5 or greater GPA
- Attend the fall semester directly after graduation
- Attend Delaware Tech as a full-time student
- Not have a felony record

DEADLINES: April 15 SEED scholarship application due

June 1 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) due

June 30 Final high school transcript due to Delaware Tech Financial Aid Office

Instructions to Apply for the SEED Scholarship

1. Submit Your Application to Delaware Tech.
 - Go to apply.dtcc.edu/
 - Click on “Create an Account.”
 - Once the account is created, scroll down to the “Next Step” section and choose “Start an Application.”
 - Complete each section of the application, including the signature page.
 - Click “Submit Application.”
 - Your application has been submitted when “Your application has been submitted” is stated under “Apply Online.”
2. Submit Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
3. Submit a SEED Scholarship Application to the Financial Aid Office of the campus where you are applying to attend (Dover, Georgetown, Stanton, or Wilmington).

4. Submit official SAT/ACT scores or participate in the college testing and placement program.
5. Submit your final official high school transcript to the Financial Aid Office of the campus where you are applying to attend (Dover, Georgetown, Stanton, or Wilmington).
6. Wait for campus notifications, which are sent after July 16.
